Code of Conduct

The *Code of Conduct* applies to all club members and athletes representing the Nanaimo Judo Club and/or the ISLAND TRAINING CENTRE. As a condition of membership to the Nanaimo Judo Club this code of conduct must be adhered to at all Judo practices, club events, tournaments, training camps, or any other events. Athletes are unequivocally obligated by this *Code* at all times while at a dojo and/or during travel to/from events. In addition to those outlined in this code, the Nanaimo Judo Club Head Coach, or ISLAND TRAINING CENTRE Head Coach has the authority to establish a reasonable set of rules for these members and athletes.

The Member Agrees:

- To treat other athletes, officials (on & off the mat), volunteers, coaches, and others with respect.
- To refrain from comments, jokes or remarks that could be considered demeaning or discriminatory to other individuals.
- To respect the rules as defined by the Head Coach, Assistant Coach(es), Team Manager, and Judo BC while at any event or activity as a member of this Club.
- To refrain from the use of alcohol if under the BC legal drinking age.
- To refrain from the use of illicit drugs including cannabis.
- To respect the social rules of the host community or country.
- To respectful use of social media with all members of the Judo community.
- To be in good standing with Judo BC as well as the Nanaimo Judo Club (Dues and Forms as required)

The Athletes also agree:

- To refrain from taking performance enhancing substances (as defined by the Canadian Center for Ethics in Sport)
- To practice respectful use of social media within the Judo community.
(This includes respecting the privacy of others by asking for consent to post video or images of others)
- To wear appropriate, clean clothing and uniforms, as well as maintain good personal hygiene.
(Hair tied up, jewelry removed or piercings taped, finger and toe nails clipped, clean body and Judogi, wear shoes off the mat and no chewing gum)
- To refrain from cell phone use while on the mats

I have read and understand the information above and agree to abide by the rules within the *Code of Conduct* and as articulated in writing by the Directors and Coaching Staff of the Nanaimo Judo Club. I understand that the violation of these rules may be dealt with at the discretion of the Directors and Coaching Staff while on site. I also understand that violation of these rules may result in discipline or sanctions as outlined in the Judo BC Policy and Procedures and or the BC Societies Act.
